The MRP is included in the DOST 11-Point Agenda of the Department of Science and Technology. The MRP has also been certified by the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) as a priority program in the 2015-2020 National Priority Plan. The study will assess the costs and benefits of LGU implementation of MRP DOST PINOY. The monetary units will be compared systematically and determine whether the benefits outweigh its costs and derive the efficiency of the intervention/ program. The social impact in terms of improving the nutritional status of the children will be assessed.
